EARTH SPEAKS V!

Art has always been a powerful tool for expressing ideas and feelings about issues of concern. The Earth Speaks V is a regional open call for a juried exhibit in the Dunning Art Gallery at Northampton Community College, Monroe Campus (Tannersville, PA) in April 2019. The Earth Speaks is an artist's means of capturing their concern regarding the climate crisis and how it affects our planet, as well as an opportunity to offer possible solutions.



Through art and creative expression, the exhibit will shine a light on:

- **Man-made issues** that pose a threat to our planet (litter, global warming, pesticides, GMOs, water pollution, over fishing, deforestation, fracking)
- **Environmental disasters** (tsunamis, hurricanes, oil spills, smog, nuclear melt-downs)
- **Ideas for solutions** (solar and wind energy, bio fuels, reduced carbon foot-print, recycling, tree planting, organic farming)

The Earth Speaks V is a regional open call for work. Artists from the following states are invit-ed to enter: ME, NH, VT, MA, CT, RI, NY, NJ, PA, VA, MD, DE, DC. \$1,000 in awards are availa-ble in a variety of mediums including 2-D, 3-D, Photography, and Printmaking. **Students are encouraged to enter.**



Juror: Harry C Tabak: Tabak's early work reflects his bond to nature through his landscape paintings. Social commentary followed with an emphasis on environmental issues for nearly two decades. These works were the subject of numerous exhibitions at the Dorsky Galleries in NYC (80's) and museums. The Wichita Art Museum sponsored a traveling exhibition titled "The Radwaste and Stonehenge Books" a series of sculptural 'books' in a collaboration with artist Nava Atlas. The series then traveled to several other mu-seums sponsored by the Art Gallery at SUNY New Paltz (now the Dorsky Museum). Tabak began to explore sculpture as a medium in 2001 utilizing found natural materials. These became the basis for his current experiments often describes as 'three dimensional draw-ings'. These are compositions utilizing wood,

stone, glass, discarded broken materials, as well as metallic objects. Mr. Tabak studied Painting and Sculpture at The Art Students League of NY; Brooklyn College.

SUBMISSION DETAILS

- Submissions will only be accepted by email.
- Only jpg image files will be accepted. Required image size is 1920 pixels on the longest side (if it is a horizontal image, 1920 pixels wide; if a vertical, 1920 pixels tall). Save your files with a resolution of 300 dpi.
- File should be named with the artists initials and numbered (ex. JCK1.jpg)
- Entries must include the attached entry form. It is the <u>ARTIST'S</u> responsibility to select the category. Students should check both student and category type.
- The Dunning Art Gallery has an installation system that requires wire for wall-hung works. There is no size restriction and sculpture must fit through a standard door. **It is the responsibility of the artist to assist with any unusual installation requirements.**
- Incomplete entries or those not meeting exhibition standards are disqualified; fees are non-refundable
- A photocopy of a valid Student I.D. must accompany all student submissions

ENTRY FEES: There is no limit to the number of entries

Student: \$15 for first 2 entries; \$10 for each additional entry

Adult: \$20 for first 2 entries; \$15 for each additional entry (**PoconoArts Members**)

\$30 for first 2 entries; \$25 for each additional entry (Non-Members)

TO ENTER ONLINE: Go to **www.poconoarts.org/earthspeaks**. Pay for the number of entries you will be submitting. Upon receipt of your payment, PoconoArts will send your receipt number via email. Enter the receipt number on the artist entry form and email, along with your jpgs, to info@poconoarts.org.

TO PAY BY CHECK: Complete the attached entry form(s) and mail it along with your payment to 18 N. 7th St., Stroudsburg, PA 18360. Please email your images to info@poconoarts.org.

NOTIFICATION: Entrants will be notified via email on or around February 15th only if he/she is ac-cepted. A list of accepted artists will also be posted on the PoconoArts website. Shipping of accepted entries to and from the show is the responsibility of the artist. <u>Please note that work must be shipped in sturdy, re-usable packagingand a prepaid return label must be included with all submissions.</u>

SALES: All work must be available for sale. Pocono Arts Council receives a commission of 20% of sale before taxes. All payments to artists will be in the form of a check mailed 30 days after the close of the show.

PRINT QUALITY: Pocono Arts Council reserves the right to disqualify any work that does not meet exhibition standards and/or work which is noticeably different than the original jpg submitted.


