Pocono Arts Council announces an art exhibition and contest open to all Monroe County and ESASD North students in grades 4 through 12. The mission is to create art relevant to this year's theme: **We Put UNITY in COMMUNITY**. This exhibition is an opportunity for young artists to express what unity means to them and their community.

One piece per student is allowed and may include **Fine Art (2-D or 3-D / Sculpture), Written / Spoken Word, or Original Music / Performance**. The artwork will be displayed and/or performed during this year's Community Night event at Northampton Community College—Monroe Campus, **Tuesday, April 30, 2024, from 6-8pm**.

Prizes will be awarded in the Junior (grades 4-8) and Senior (grades 9-12) Divisions for *Best in Category* in 1.) 2-D Fine Art, 2.) 3-D/Sculptural Fine Art, 3.) Written/Spoken Word, and 4.) Original Music or Performance. An overall *Best in Show* will also be selected.

No Entry Fee. Late work will not be accepted.

- ⇒ Artwork must be **hang-ready**, i.e., mounted on a board or framed.
- ⇒ Artwork and ID Form must be delivered to Pocono Arts Council (530 Main Street, Stroudsburg) no later than **Tuesday, April 23, 2024, at 4pm**.
- ⇒ **Large artwork** must be delivered directly to Pocono Hall at NCC—Monroe Campus on Monday, April 29, 2024, between 3-6pm. Please call (570) 476-4460 or email info@poconoarts.org with questions.
- ⇒ **Students who wish to perform** (poetry, music, dance) must email this form and a link to a recording of their performance to info@poconoarts.org by Tuesday, April 23, 2024, at 4pm. Performance slots will be assigned.
- ⇒ **Award winners** will be announced during the event. Following Community Night, winning pieces will be on display at the Monroe County Administration Building (One Quaker Plaza, Stroudsburg) for one year.
- ⇒ All other artworks must be picked up the night of the event – OR – at Pocono Arts Council (530 Main Street, Stroudsburg) no later than Friday, May 3, 2024, at 6pm. **Abandoned artwork will not be stored.**
