## Oksenhendler & Cosgrove Featured at PoconoArts Cultural Center

Featured ArtSpace artist for July is Marcos Oksenhendler. Born in Morocco, Marcos studied at the Fashion Institute of Technology where he now teachers. He is a board member of the Pocono Community Theater and Chairperson of the Visual Arts Committee. His work can be found in collections both locally and nationally and he is an active participant in the work of the Pocono Arts council. Additional artists in the ArtSpace Gallery include Thomas Augusta, David Cook, Sharon Cosgrove, Will Daskal, Denise Darvón, Shirley Epstein, Jim Hannan, Helen Heeren, Marlana Holsten, John Kopp, Linda Kreckel, Don Manza, Joan Sayer, and Clarissa Jan Ward.

The PoconoArts Studio Gallery features the oils of Sharon Cosgrove. Born in Washington DC, Sharon is a Professor of Art at Wilkes University where she teaches undergraduate courses in painting and printmaking, and also maintains a private studio. She holds a BFA, MA, and MFA from the University of New Mexico and a BA from Shepherd College. Her paintings and prints have been exhibited in over fifty invitational, solo, and juried shows, nationally and internationally and can be found in both public and private collections. Serving in an "ambassadorial" role for cross-cultural exchange, Sharon's work was selected for the Art in Embassies Program sponsored by the U.S. Department of State and was displayed at the U.S. Embassy in Astana, Kazakhstan. As part of this program, she also traveled to Kazakhstan in March 2012 to offer presentations and master classes in conjunction with women's history month. Sharon is the recipient of the Medici Award in Painting from the International Biennale Exhibition of Contemporary Art, in Florence, Italy, and has been Visiting Artist at the Brandywine Workshop in Philadelphia, The International

Harris Fogel is an Associate Professor and Program Director of Photography, and Director/Curator of the Sol Mednick Gallery and Gallery 1401 at the University of the Arts in Philadelphia. Mr. Fogel has a long exhibition record, and his photographic work is in major museum collections in the U.S. and abroad. He has written for art and photo-related publications and projects, and has taught the history of photography for more than 20 years. He has served as a portfolio reviewer at FotoFest in Houston, PhotoLucida in Portland, and at annual SPE national conferences. In 2012, he was named to the Fulbright Specialist roster. He visited Łódź, Poland, to participate in the 2012 annual International Fotofestival of Photography as one of the festival's visiting experts. His trip was sponsored by U.S. Embassy in Warsaw. One of his longstanding interests is placing contemporary work within a larger historical contextual framework.

## Gary Kresge Commissioned Work to be Unveiled

In March 2012 at its Spring for the Arts auction, the PoconoArts Council celebrated the visual art of Gary Kresge as its first Hall of Fame recipient and jazz musician Bob Dorough with a Lifetime Achievement Award. As part of Mr. Kresge's Hall of Fame Award, PoconoArts will purchase a specially designed commissioned painting, Falls on Tobyhanna Creek, which will be on permanent display at the PoconoArts Cultural Center. 


